



Lesson: Meter Matters!

Objectives: Students will learn to compose music that connects meter in music to meter in poetry and text.

Procedure:

1. Discuss the use of meter in text using appropriate examples, such as a hymnal with an index by meter and/or poetic meter:

2. Have students select a set of lyrics and identify the meter of the text.
3. Create a new score in Notion and select the instruments for the composition. Add a title to the song that matches the selected text and compose a short melody that matches the meter of the text.
4. Once the melody is complete, add the text using the lyric tool. Use example lyric sheets to demonstrate the proper method for spacing syllables.
5. Have students print their song for the class and then perform using the playback in Notion. This can be done by either singing or reading the text in rhythm over the playback.
